Jackson Family Residence Summer Health Event



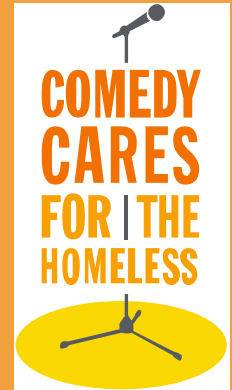
