EQUITY IN HEALTH CARE - Homeless New Yorkers suffer disproportionately from poor health. CFH addresses these disparities by delivering high-quality, accessible, and culturally competent health care, regardless of an individual's ability to pay.

WOMEN'S SHELTER - We opened Susan's Place, a 200-bed shelter for women, in 2008. Since then, over 1,400 women have gotten back on their feet and found permanent housing. With the same goals in mind, we opened the 52nd Street Women's Center in 2019. It houses and supports 120 women.

PRIMARY CARE - Our comprehensive primary care services provide patients with physicals, vaccinations, health screenings, care coordination, and referrals for specialty care when needed.

PEDIATRICS - Our pediatric services include health and wellness

episodic illness care. Homeless children are sick four times more often than those who are housed. We help keep them healthy and in school.

DENTAL CARE - Oral health is one of the biggest unmet needs for homeless New Yorkers. Our dental program treats the serious impact of poor oral hygiene and trauma and provides patients with oral health education.

HEALTH MANAGEMENT - Thousands of patients receive support through education and counseling on heart health, asthma, diabetes, HIV awareness, smoking cessation, health insurance enrollment, and more.

MENTAL HEALTH & SUBSTANCE ABUSE - CFH's team of mental health professionals and substance abuse counselors provide holistic care and wellness programming, empowering patients through evaluations, therapy, medication assisted treatment, and group sessions.
